

# LABOR FEST 2014



## POSTER CONTEST

*Theme: “Unity of Community”*

One entry per person. No corporations allowed. Individuals only.

**Prizes to be awarded:** 1<sup>st</sup> Place \$500.00 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$100.00

**Entry Fee:** \$5.00

### **Entry requirements:**

Entries must be on a foam core board, 20 x 30 x 3/16. Any color foam core board is acceptable. Contestants must provide an 11 x 17 color printout of the entry and entry must be saved to a CD or memory stick. The Labor Fest printer must have access to copy.

Artistic medium for the image to be displayed on the foam core can be any medium that resists fading and deterioration such as crayon, marker, acrylics, etc. Entry must NOT be 3D.

The words “Unity of Community” must be displayed prominently. The official Labor Fest color logo must be at least 1½ inches in size and no larger than 2 inches. It can be displayed anywhere on the foam core board, preferably blended to match the artwork for best effect. The Labor Fest logo must be correct color and sizing and comes with the solicitation packet, see oval shaped logo above and on 2<sup>nd</sup> page.

Art must be original. Using any components that are not original is highly discouraged. Using copyrighted material is forbidden unless the artist secures permission from the copyright holder. This is the sole responsibility of the contestant. Labor Fest 2014 is not responsible for any and all infringements of the use of intellectual property and will reject any entries which is knowingly plagiarized.

All entries will become the sole property of the Labor Fest 2014. Artists relinquish all rights and royalties to said entries upon receiving and acceptance of notice. Labor Fest 2014 reserves the right to reject and return any foam cores deemed inappropriate or in violation of these rules.

All entry forms must be completely filled out in English and must be legible.

**Mandatory Information to include in poster/on foamcore:**

- 1) DATE: September 1, 2014 or the words Labor Day 2014
- 2) FESTIVAL NAME: Grand Rapids Labor Fest 2014
- 3) PLACE: Words denoting “at Ah-Nab-Awen Park” or “along the Grand River at the Ford Presidential Museum” or any combination of wording.....Readers must know where to go!
- 4) TIME: 11:00am - 5:00pm
- 5) MUSIC: Live music or bands(can check website or call to find out what bands)
- 6) THEME: “Unity of Community”(prominently displayed)
- 7) LABOR FEST PICTURE/LOGO see below (anywhere on board)
- 8) HIGHLIGHTS: Free admission to the Gerald R. Ford Presidential Museum.
- 9) MISC(not all mandatory): Words denoting various local food vendors, beer tent, vintage auto show, children’s rides & games, arts & crafts vendors, American made/union made product displays.

**Judging Process:**

**Round I** – Review of all entries.

**Round II** – Entries will be narrowed to the top 10.

**Round III** – 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place winners will be picked from the top 10 entries.

The top 10 entries will be on public display at Labor Fest on Labor Day.

Winners will be expected to have their photos taken and published in the local, regional and national media. Entrants who are under the age of 18 must have permission of the parent or legal guardian to have their photo taken and published. Winners may be expected to attend a brief award ceremony as part of Labor Fest on Labor Day.

**All entries must be submitted by July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014.**
